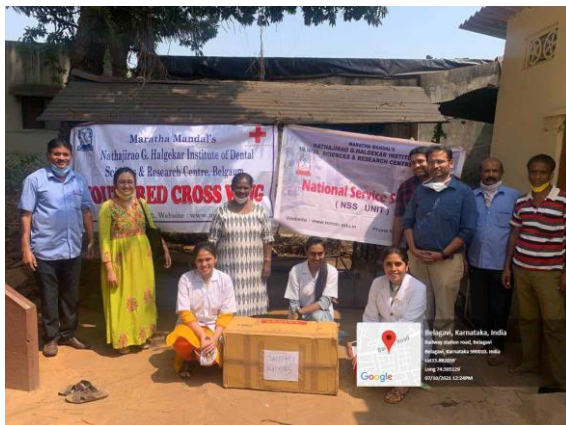
WORLD HEALTH DAY

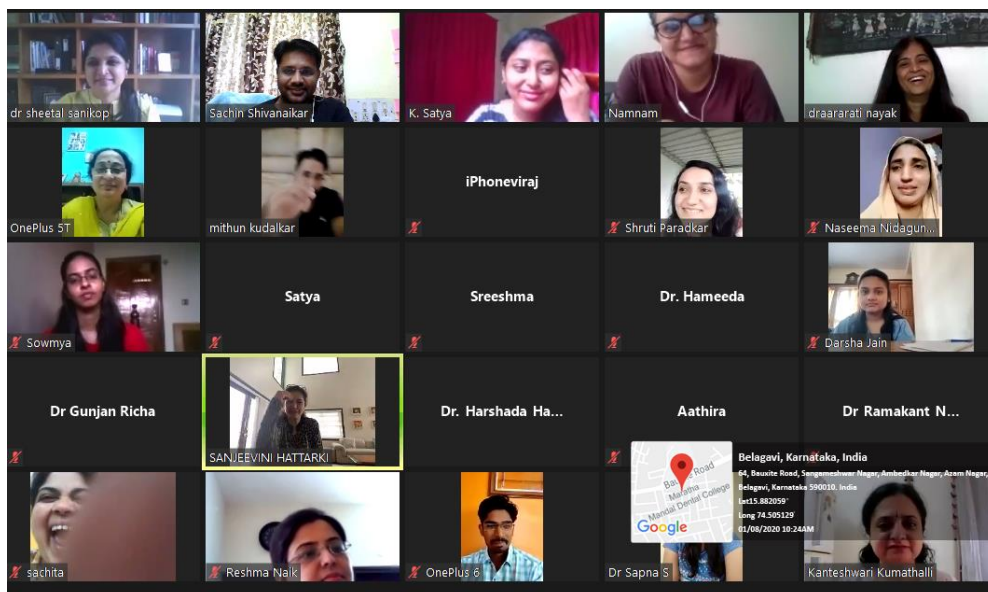
BLOOD DONATION CAMP

Virtual oral hygiene day and alumni meet was conducted by Department of Periodontology on 1st August 2020. All the alumni shared their experiences and cherished the memories.

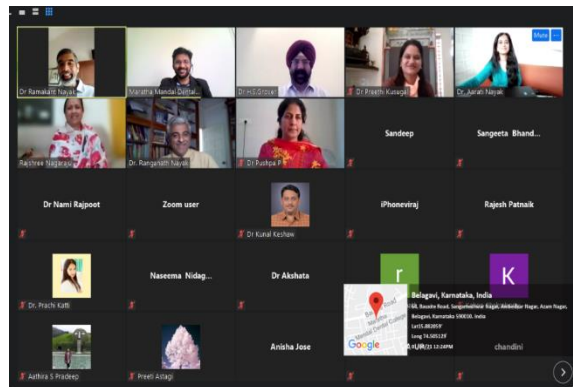

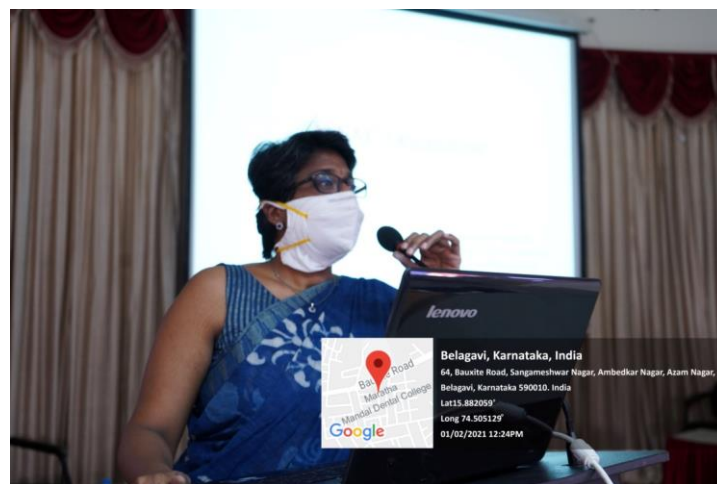
ORIENTATION PROGRAMME 2018-2019
