
MANAGEMENT OF PATIENT WITH RIDGE DEFECT WITH ANDREW'S BRIDGE


A patient with several missing teeth in the anterior aesthetic region along with severe ridge defect poses a greater challenge for prosthodontic rehabilitation. In such cases treatment using fixed partial denture (FPD) may not be feasible because of the extent of edentulous span and the periodontal conditions of the abutment teeth.. In such situations it is wise to select a combination of fixed partial prosthesis and removable partial prosthesis, which is going to tackle most of the existing problems in the compromised dental arches. The advantages of the Andrew's bridge system includes better aesthetics, hygiene along with better adaptability and phonetics. It is comfortable and economical for patients. There is no palatal extension as in the case of removable partial dentures. Good soft tissue response due to less soft tissue impingement. This type of prosthesis is more retentive and stable with minimal extension



MAXILLARY SINGLE COMPLETE DENTURE AND MANDIBULAR OCCLUSAL REHABILITATION USING CUSTOM MADE OCCLUSAL PLANE TEMPLATE

Single complete denture is the type of denture that occludes against some or all natural teeth, a fixed restoration, or a previously constructed removable partial denture or complete denture. A custom made occlusal template was fabricated in this case using a volley ball. This occlusal plane template was used to restore the occlusal anatomy of the remaining attrited mandibular natural teeth and establish the curve of spee and curve of monsoon.













REMOVABLE PROTHDODNTICS

TOOTH SUPPORTED OVERDENTURE



REHABILITATION OF COMPLETELY EDENTULOUS MANDIBULAR ARCH WITH NEUTRAL ZONE

NEUTRAL ZONE is the zone of equilibrium in which the outward forces exerted by tongue to counter balance the inward forces of lips and cheeks in complete denture fabrication. The advantages of neutral zone technique are improved stability and retention, posterior teeth will be correctly positioned allowing sufficient tongue space. This procedure should be performed for the all-complete edentulous patients with resorbed ridges to increase the denture stability.











REHABILITATION OF CLASS TWO EDENTULOUS ARCHES WITH COMPLETE DENTURES INCLUDING BALANCING RAMP


Balancing ramps provide a tripodization the denture bases as the petient moves the mandible from centric relation to a protrusive or a lateral postions. There is a smooth contact anteriorly on the teeth and posteriorly on the ramps.



IMPLANT PROSTHODONTICS

IMPLANT SUPPORTED OVERDENTURE

Implant- supported overdentures are a treatment alternative for many patients for whom conventional dentures are poorly tolerated. In ridges where the bone support is low for the retention of conventional complete dentures, the placement of implants in order to retain the denture gives the patient better masticatory efficiency and comfort. This type of denture has higher probability of success compared to overdentures supported by the roots of the natural teeth or the ones dependent on tissue for support.



RESTORATION OF ANTERIOR MISSING TEETH BY IMPLANT SUPPORTED POULO MALO'S BRIDGE

In case of missing anterior teeth with large bony defects, conventional fixed partial denture possesses a challenge for rehabilitation which results in compromised esthetics. Hence, an innovate technique comprising of implant placement followed by an innovative crown and bridge procedure which is known as Paulo Malo's bridge. It enhances the aesthetics in cases with severe ridge defect


OCCULAR PROSTHESIS

Severe physical and psychological distress occurs due to disfigurement caused by loss of eye. Psychological distress associated with the loss of eye can be significantly improved by an ocular prosthesis, simulating the natural eye. The ocular prosthesis is an artificial replacement for the bulb of the eye. After the surgeon enucleates the eye, prosthodontist is a person who comes into an act of providing the patient with an artificial eye to overcome the agony of losing an eye. A well-made and properly made ocular prosthesis maintains its orientation when patient performs various movements. The patient cannot see by this prosthesis, this prosthesis will increase the self-confidence of the patient to face the world.

CORRECTION OF MANDIBULAR DEVIATION BY GUIDING FLANGE.

Guiding flange prosthesis is a mandibular conventional prosthesis designed for the patient who is able to achieve an appropriate mediolateral position of the mandible but is unable to repeat this position consistently for adequate mastication. Loss of continuity of the mandible destroys the balance and symmetry of mandibular function leading to altered mandibular movements, facial asymmetry, malocclusion and deviation of the residual fragment towards the surgical side. It helps in improving the confidence of the patient along with pleasing esthetics










FULL MOUTH REHABILITATION

Full mouth rehabilitation is done in cases with severely worn out dentition with compromised occlusion. Cases with severe attrition compromises the esthetics and function of the patient. In order to improve the esthetics and function and reducing the sensitivity full mouth restoration of the teeth with crowns and bridges is performed.


PATIENT EDUCATION PROGRAM (7/10/2021)

The Post Graduates of Department of Periodonology performed a role play on Immunology by enacting the different roles of cells to depict the functions of these cells.










RAPID REVISION COURSE (2020)




NATIONAL ORAL PATHOLOGIST DAY








CDE PROGRAM
