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

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

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

And

The Maratha Mandal's Central Research Laboratory, Maratha Mandal's Nathajirao G. Halgekar Institute of Dental Sciences & Research Centre, Belagavi, having its office at Belagavi, Karnataka hereinafter referred to as 'MMCRL', represented by its Principal.

RGUHS and MMCRL will together be called 'Parties' Now it is hereby agreed between the Parties:

The primary goals of this MoU are:

1. To foster collaborative research between teachers of the affiliated colleges of RGUHS and scientist at MMCRL based on the matching of research questions and interests between the two groups.

2. To allow access to facilities at MMCRL, such as molecular biology set up, anaerobic & aerobic bacteriology, tissue culture laboratory, immunological techniques, microscopy etc. as a service component to researchers of affiliated colleges of RGUHS on cost per test basis.

The above-mentioned goals are to be accomplished subject to the following conditions:

1. A workgroup consisting of representatives of RGUHS and representatives of MMCRL, which will co-ordinate the activities to be taken up at MMCRL under this MoU will be formed for achieving the goal No.1 mentioned above, this group shall meet as often required to discuss issue pertaining to research.

2. While this agreement will form a framework, specific agreements or details need to be drawn up for carrying out specific collaborative activities, which the parties

agree to draw up as appropriate. A committee shall be set up for this with representatives from RGUHS and MMCRL to take decisions in this matter.

Without being exclusive, exchange of collaborators (faculty, other staff members, undergraduate and postgraduate students), teaching and training, submission of joint applications for competitive research projects, hosting joint meeting and workshops are envisaged under this agreement.

1. The parties shall develop their tasks and activities under this agreement according to applicable institutional standards and procedures.

2.
