#### 11/02/2021

HOD meeting was held on 05/02/2021 to discuss following Agenda.

- 1. To discuss the protocol & difficulties in managing the clinics
- 2. Online & offline classes.
- 3. Any other matter
  - a) Extension of timing for teaching staff for off campus work
  - b) To maintain movement register for staff at department
  - c) BMW management
  - d) Teaching beyond class rooms for students

Principal commenced the meeting by welcoming all the members. He informed about that vice Principal Dr. Viraj Patil & HOD Dr. Madhu Pujar are on leave. In place of Dr. Madhu, Dr .V.M Uppin represented the department of Conservative Dentistry and Endodontics.

The details of action taken report for the above mentioned agenda.

- 1) All HOD's were of the opinion to currently continue the OPD timing same till i.e., 1.30 pm till end of March. Taking into consideration situation of COVID further decision on extension of OPD timing can be made.
- 2) It was decided by discussion with all, to stop movement of attender to each department taking case paper along with patient. It was decided that patient will carry their own case paper, henceforth, along with them for treatment and deposit in department/reception counter while leaving hospital.
- 3) Principal asked all dept if they have any deficiency of attenders and required any new attenders.

Dr. Hallikerimath informed about requirement of one extra attenders.

Principal informed that if there is requirement of attender all the HOD's who require extra attender to give letter stating the work load of existing attenders and if new one is recruited what work will be assigned for him/her.

Individually when enquired with each department Dr. Yavagal informed that two days a week the dept suffers with day to day activity because one attendres is posted to CRL two days a week. If that is stopped dept do not require new attender

- 4) Principal mentioned that if attenders are called for some office work, they are not to be sent. They are to be sent only if HOD's receive any circular or written document signed by principal. Also it was mentioned if attenders are busy doing work at dept. Dept need not send them for office work.

#### Any other matter:
