READ:

In this regard University had invited applications for financial assistance for conducting of advanced research projects for the year 2015-16. University had received 366 research proposals. The University had earmarked Rs.5.00 crores in its budget estimate for the year 2015-16 for this purpose. In order to meet this expenditure the concerned Subject Experts as suggested by the concerned BOS PG chairpersons and the Expert Committee comprising of all the BOS PG chairpersons have scrutinized the proposals and shortlisted them based on the criteria set out by the University. Such of the proposals which have fulfilled the norms have been recommended by the Expert Committee for sanction of grants.

The Syndicate in its 116th meeting held on 16th December 2015 has approved to sanction the grant-in-aid as per the recommendations of Expert Committee for 159 selected proposals in medical, dental, pharmacy, ayurveda, nursing, physiotherapy, allied health sciences and BNYS faculties for the year 2015-16.

The Grant-in-aid will be released in the name of Principal of Maratha Mandal's NGH Institute of Dental Sciences & Research Centre, Belgaum subject to following terms and conditions mentioned hereunder.

- The Principal / Head of Institution shall open a separate joint account for the financial grant released by RGUHS in the name of Principal / Head of the Institution and the Principal Investigator.
- 2. Principal / Head of the Institution and the Principal Investigator shall be responsible for the accounts and the proper utilization of the funds. The grants released shall be used only for research purpose.
- 3. 50% of the grant-in-aid approved by RGUHS shall be released as 1st installment. 25% of the grant-in-aid shall be released after the Utilization Certificate for the money released in the 1st installment is given. The honorarium for the supportive staff, purchase of consumables, tests carried outside the institution because of lack of infrastructural facilities in the institution, travel grants for attending conference for presenting the research work and for publication of papers in national / indexed journals shall be met out of the grant-in-aid.
- 15. After the completion of the project the entire project report shall be submitted to the University and will become property of the University.
- 16.If any of the conditions mentioned above are not adhered to by the Principal/ Head of the Institution and the Principal Investigator, University reserves the right to take appropriate action.





- 12. It is the responsibility of the Principal/Head of the Institution and Principal Investigator to ensure that research work is completed within the stipulated time.
- 13. The grants released by the University shall not be utilized for the purpose of purchase of equipments.
- 14. The honorarium for the supportive staff, purchase of consumables, tests carried outside the institution because of lack of infrastructural facilities in the institution, travel grants for attending conference for presenting the research work and for publication of papers in national / indexed journals shall be met out of the grant-in-aid.
- 15. After the completion of the project the entire project report shall be submitted to the University and will become property of the University.
- 16.If any of the conditions mentioned above are not adhered to by the Principal/ Head of the Institution and the Principal Investigator, University reserves the right to take appropriate action.
- 17.In research proposals involving clinical trials, if any untoward incidence occurs, it is the responsibility of the Principal Investigator and the

Dr. Ramakant Nayak Principal Institution to deal with the same and the University will not take any responsibility in this regard. The Principal Investigator is advised to enter into insurance schemes to meet any such adverse eventuality as per the decision of the IEC.

Further the Principal / Head of the Institution and Principal Investigator has to submit a joint affidavit duly signed by both of the Principal / Head of the Institution and Principal Investigator which has to be notarized mentioning all the conditions from Sl.No.1 to 17 and stating that they will be abide by the conditions stipulated in this order.

Only after the receipt of Pre-receipt certificate and the affidavit as above, further process for release of research grant-in-aid will be initiated. These documents have to be submitted to the Director, Advanced Research, RGUHS (superscribing the documents as ("Advanced Research proposal") either in person or by post on or before 18th January 2016 without fail. Soft copies of these documents shall also be sent to rguhsresearch@gmail.com before 18th January 2016.

Cheque has to be collected in person at Advanced Research Wing of RGUHS after the intimation from the University and no representatives are allowed to collect the cheque.



On behalf of Prof. (Dr.) Balram Bhargava, Secretary, Department of Health Research (DHR) and Director
General, Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) applications are invited from interested MBBS/BDS **
students (1st year to 4th year (before appearing in 4th year final exams) to participate in the Short 3
Term Studentship-2022 (STS-2022).

The ICMR initiated the STS Program in 1979 in order to promote interest and aptitude for research among medical undergraduates. The main objective of this program is to provide an opportunity to undergraduate medical students to familiarize themselves with research methodology and techniques by being associated for a short duration with their seniors on ongoing research program or by undertaking independent projects. It was expected that this may serve as an incentive for them to take up research as a career in the future.

- During the last 37 years, medical/dental undergraduate students of various MCI/DCI recognized medical/dental colleges in the country have shown keen interest in ICMR-STS Program. The ICMR has decided to continue this program by awarding limited number of studentships to deserving MBBS/BDS students for the year 2022.

ASSESSMENT OF COTININE LEVELS IN SALIVA AMONG SMOKERS AND NON-SMOKERS IN BELAGAVI CITY-A CLINICAL STUDY

Introduction: -

Tobacco tends to kill up to half its users.

Tobacco kills over eight million individuals per annum. Over seven million deaths are the results of direct tobacco use, whereas around 1.2 million are the results of non-smokers being exposed to second-hand smoke

India's tobacco downside is extremely complicated, with massive use of a range of smoking techniques. Over 80% of the world's population i.e. 1.3 billion tobacco users reside in developing countries Among numerous elements, nicotine is the primary addictive part of tobacco products that act on the brain.

Cotinine is the major metabolite of nicotine and results from the metabolism of nicotine by the cytochrome 2A6 enzyme system within the liver. It has been determined that nicotine is being transported to the brain in barely ten to twenty seconds and starts its action.

It's the current marker of alternative for the absorption of tobacco exposure attributable to its comparatively long half-life (ten times longer than that of nicotine). Cotinine measurements from human body fluids will offer an assessment of recent exposure to tobacco however, they do not indicate the period of exposure.

Cotinine has been isolated in plasma, urine, saliva, and gingival crevicular fluid. Saliva is going to be utilized in our study because it is non-invasive and it's simple to gather while not inflicting a lot of discomfort to the patients. Hence, we tend to aim to research the amount of cotinine in pure smokers and non-smokers visiting our dental institute from a secretion sample, by performing reverse-phase high-performance liquid chromatography and understanding the statistics by SEM and Students t-test and procure the Pearson coefficient of correlation analysis, by calculating P-value to grasp the statistically significant

Objectives

- 1) Quantitative assessment of cotinine in salivary sample among smokers and non-smokers
- 2) Tobacco exposure in 15-45 years people and its dependence

Methodologies

Population

Data are going to be collected from the participants visiting our institution's Oral Medicine and Radiology department. This cross-sectional study can embody smokers and non-smokers for over one year or more, who are going to be elected from sampling. Our current study can embody a complete of 30-50 cigarette smokers and 30-50 non-smokers with no underlying medical problems and no habit of a chewing variety of tobacco respectively. where the age group shall be starting from 15 to 45 years of age, which will be divided into Pure cigarette smokers as cluster I and non-smokers as cluster II.

<u>Sample collection</u> - Five milliliters of unstimulated whole salivary samples will be obtained by expectoration, in the absence of chewing movements, in dry plastic vials with the participants sitting in a relaxed position.

<u>Sample preparation</u> - The collected saliva samples will be centrifuged at 3,000 rpm for 10 min. The supernatants will be stored at -70°C until further analysis is done.

<u>Instrumentation</u> – Shimadzu HPLC system & C18 (250 * 4.6 mm, internal diameter 5 um) with Photodiode-Array Detection (PDA) detector will be used for quantification

Reversed-phase high-performance liquid chromatography conditions -

Mobile phase- suitable mobile phase will be selected after optimization of chromatographic conditions as follows

- 1) Mobile phase consisting of a mixture of 0.27 gm of KH_2PO_4 , 0.814 gm of sodium 1-heptane sulfonate,820 ml of water, and 180 ml of methanol & Flow between 1ml/min with a wavelength of 256 nm
- 2) Methanol: phosphate buffer PH 7.9 (35:65 v/v)

This study can enforce an associate epidemiologic study to assess tobacco exposure as it's a non-invasive technique of grouping samples. Our study can give relation concerning the cotinine levels within the body and therefore the effects of its dependence on the people and its consequences on morbidity.

INTRODUCTION:

Globally cancer of the lip and oral cavity forms about 2% of all malignancies. It is the 16th most common

cancer in the world. The incidence of its occurrence has significant geographic variations and gender

predilection with maximum cases recorded in south central Asia mainly comprising India, Bangladesh,

Sri Lanka, Nepal and Pakistan ,leading to 65.8% of incident rate worldwide.1

In India, oral cancer accounts for 10.3% of all the malignancies and ranks third in mortality due to

cancer. The prevalence of this disease in this area is mainly due to the habit of betel quid chewing, tobacco

smoking, overconsumption of alcohol etc. It's found to be predominant among men than in women which

can be justified by presence of these deleterious habits higher in men, resulting in 16.2% and 4.6% incident

rate in men and women respectively.1

Regardless of advancement in treatment like surgery, radiation, immunotherapy and chemotherapy, oral

cancer still accounts for 1, 77,757 of total deaths recorded worldwide. Lesser survival rate, poor prognosis

corresponding to diagnosis at a late stage, side effects and high expenses arising from existing treatment

have directed us in search for safer treatment using routinely used medicinal plants with lesser side effect

and better outcome.

Historically, the use of natural herbs in curing ailments has been evident. Moreover, their usage in treating

cancer is of high interest in present times. Various types of herbal plants that are used on regular basis for

culinary purpose such as basil, cardamom, cinnamon, clove, coriander, cumin, garlic, ginger, and saffron

are said to be used in cancer treatment.2

Keeping this in mind we thought of evaluating the anticancer and antioxidant property of ajwain. Ajwain

(Trachyspermum ammi) is a herbal plant, with seed like fruit and pungent taste with various medicinal

and pharmacological properties as antimicrobial, anti-inflammatory, cytotoxic, antifungal, antispasmodic,

antitussive actions. A total of 26 recognized components are being detected in Ajwain essential oil but

chief active components include thymol and carvacrol both having antiseptic, antitussive and expectorant properties. Its anticancer potential has been proved in certain studies for breast carcinomas. 4

On doing literature search, there was lack of studies regarding the usage of anticancer and antioxidant activity of Ajwain on oral cancer cell lines. Hence this study will be first of its kind intended to evaluate anticancer potency of Ajwain on oral cancer cell lines.

OBJECTIVES:

The main objective of the current study is:

- To evaluate the antioxidant property of ethanolic extract of Ajwain on oral cancer cell lines
- To evaluate anticancer property of ethanolic extract of Ajwain on oral cancer cell lines

METHODOLOGY:

Study design and setting: It will be a laboratory experimental study (in-vitro) conducted in the research laboratory within our institution.

Study duration: The experimental study involving evaluation of anticancer and antioxidant activity shall begin right after approval of the proposal and will be completed within a period of two months between May - June. The report writing will be done in the months of July - August.

Instruments used: Instruments required are easily accessible in the research laboratory present in our institution where the study will be conducted and can be categorized as below:

Major instruments:

- Fluorescent microscope
- Carbon dioxide incubator

Study tool and procedure: Oral cancer cell lines will be procured (NCC) and will be maintained till the completion of study.

1. Collection and authentication of plant-

Ajwain plant will be collected from our medicinal garden and authentication of plant will be done from ICMR- NITM Belagavi.⁵

2. Preparation of ethanolic extract of ajwain

Ajwain plant (leaf) collected from our medicinal garden will be later shade dried. The shade dried plant will be finely powdered and extracted using absolute ethanol (99%) at room temperature for 48 hour. After filtration, the solution will be concentrated under vacuum and dried at room temperature to get dry residue.⁵

3. Phytochemical analysis:

The phytochemical analysis of ethanolic extracts of Ajwain will be done. We will qualitatively test the phytochemical contents such as; alkaloids, flavonoids, glycosides, phenols, lignins, saponins, sterols, tannins, anthraquinones and reducing sugar.⁵

4. Determination of antioxidant activity by using in vitro methods:

We will quantify the total antioxidant power of the extracts using 2, 2-Diphenyl-1 picrylhydrazyl radical scavenging ability (DPPH) assay and ABTS Antioxidant Assay.⁵

5. Cytotoxicity

We will check cytotoxicity by MTT Assay. Briefly approximately 5×10^3 cells/well will be seeded in 96-well flat-bottom micro plate. The plate will be kept overnight at 37°C in 95% humidity and 5% CO₂. Different concentrations of samples will be treated and then the cells will be incubated for another 48 hours. The cells in well will be washed twice with phosphate buffer solution. 20 μ L of the MTT staining solution (5mg/ml in phosphate buffer solution) will be added to each well and plate will be incubated at 37°C. After 4h, 100 μ L of di-methyl sulfoxide (DMSO) will be added to each well to dissolve the formazan crystals, and absorbance will recorded with a 570 nm using micro plate reader.

Using graph Pad Prism Version 5.1, we shall calculate the IC 50.

6. Detection of mitochondrial transmembrane potential

We will quantify the mitochondrial transmembrane potential by Rhadamine dye using fluorescence microscope.⁷

7. 4',6-diamidino-2-phenylindole (DAPI) staining

We will check the morphological changes of apoptosis of cells by DAPI staining using fluorescence microscope. 8

8. Flow cytometry analysis apoptosis

We will check the quantitative apoptosis of cells by Annexin V and PI dye using flow cytometry.⁹

9. Flow cytometry analysis cell cycle

We will check the cell cycle analysis by PI dye using flow cytometry. 10

Statistical analysis: One way analysis of variance (ANOVA) followed by Tukey test will be applied for finding out significant differences in the antioxidant power and cell viability obtained through ABTS antioxidant and MTT Assay respectively.

Ethical consideration: Since it is an in vitro study it will not involve any animal or human trials while conducting the experiments. Nonetheless, ethics committee approval will be taken from the institutional ethics committee prior to beginning of the study.

Quality control: For every experiment that will be conducted Cisplatin (anticancer drug) will be kept as positive control and untreated cell lines as negative control. The data obtained through assays will be entered, with relevant data checks so as to avoid errors in data entry and analysis will be done using graph Pad Prism Version 5.1.

IMPLICATIONS:

The study will mainly assess the anticancer and antioxidant activity of Ajwain extract on oral cancer cell lines. If the *in-vitro* study will be found to be effective, further animal studies and human trials can be carried out to evaluate the antioxidant and anticancer effect of Ajwain in treating oral cancer and oral pre malignant disorders. This will help us to reduce the cancer burden among general public and will also give us a cost effective treatment option.

Title: Comparative evaluation of antimicrobial effect, antibiofilm effect and quorum sensing inhibition of Clitoria Ternatea and Chlorhexidine against Streptococcus mutans.

INTRODUCTION

Streptococcus mutans (S. mutans) is a gram-positive facultative anaerobic bacterium that is the primary causative agent in the progression of dental caries, causing irreversible damage to the tooth. The natural habitat of S. mutans is the human oral cavity, more precisely the dental plaque. Caries causing bacteria can produce antibacterial resistance by colonizing on the tooth surface and forming a distinctive extracellular polymeric matrix network which leads to the development of oral infectious diseases.

Dental caries is a common biofilm-dependent oral disease in humans, which manifests itself as a progressive demineralization of calcareous tissues caused by the various complicated interactions between acid-generating bacteria and fermentable carbohydrates.

Commonly used anti-cariogenic agents are 2% Chlorhexidine (CHX), Sodium fluoride, Stannous fluoride of which 2% Chlorhexidine is currently the most potent chemotherapeutic agent against *S. mutans*.

Clitoria ternatea (C. ternatea), commonly called as butterfly pea plant has been used as traditional medicine in various diseases. It is scientifically researched for its anti-inflammatory, antipyretic, analgesic, larvicidal, insecticidal, antimicrobial, anxiolytic, antidepressant, tranquilizing and sedative properties. Several studies have demonstrated C. ternatea to be an effective antimicrobial agent due to its antimicrobial effect against various pathogens such as Escherichia coli, Vibrio cholerae, S. mutans, Staphylococcus aureus, Porphyromonas gingivalis, etc.

Natural products from various medicinal plants have been recognised for their potential antibacterial activities with novel mechanism that are more effective and less toxic. This discourages using harmful chemicals and encourages using plant-based products that are more sustainable and eco-friendlier.¹

As very limited published reports concerning the antimicrobial activity of C. ternatea against dental pathogens are available. Hence, this study focuses on the evaluation of antimicrobial effect, antibiofilm effect and quorum sensing inhibition ability of extracts from C. ternatea plant in comparison to 2% Chlorhexidine against S. mutans.

OBJECTIVES

- Evaluation of the antimicrobial effect of Clitoria ternatea and 2% Chlorhexidine against *S. mutans*.
- Evaluation of the antibiofilm effects of Clitoria ternatea and 2% Chlorhexidine against S. mutans.
- Evaluation of quorum sensing inhibition of Clitoria ternatea and 2% Chlorhexidine against S. mutans.
- Comparison of effects of Clitoria ternatea and 2% Chlorhexidine on antimicrobial effect, antibiofilm effect and quorum sensing inhibition against S. mutans.

METHODOLOGY:

Group 1: Clitoria ternatea

Group 2: 2% chlorohexidine

Ethanolic Clitoria ternatea leaf extract:

To prepare the ethanolic leaf extract, fresh leaves (100g) of the Clitoria ternatea plant will be dried and powdered. The powder will be transferred to a 500ml sterile conical flask and 500ml of ethanol will be added to this powder following which the flask will be covered and placed on an orbital shaper for 3 days (72 hours). The extract obtained after 3 days will be filtered through a No.1 Whatman filter paper and the crude extract will be vaporised to dryness using a rotary evaporator to obtain the C. ternatea compound.¹

Preparation of bacteria and bacterial growth:

S. mutans (ATCC 25175) will be cultured in Brain Heart Infusion Agar (BHIA) at 37°C and incubated overnight. For the antibacterial assay, the inoculum will be diluted in the sterile saline solution.

Antimicrobial assay:

Zone of Inhibition:

The zone of inhibition of C. ternatea and Chlorhexidine (Group 1 and group 2 respectively) against S. mutans will be done by Agar well diffusion method. S. mutans (ATCC 25175) will be cultured in Brain Heart Infusion Agar (BHIA). Wells will be prepared in the plates where S. mutans is cultured. 50µl of C. ternatea compound and 50 µl of 2% Chlorhexidine will be placed in the wells respectively and incubated at 37°C for 24-48 hours. Further, the inhibition zone will be measured (in mm)¹.

Antibiofilm effect:

Biofilms formation and antibiofilm effect of test groups (Group 1 and group 2) will be done in 96-well microtiter plates. For this, 200 µl of the inoculum of S. mutans strain in single culture will be pipetted in the wells and the plates, incubated at 37 °C for 48-72 hours. The resulting biofilms will be then washed with phosphate buffered saline.

For biofilm treatment, a volume of 200 μ l of each treatment solution (2% chlorohexidine and C. ternatea compound) will be added to the wells, and the plates will be incubated for 24 hours at 37 °C. The antibiofilm effects of the compounds will be evaluated by quantification of colony-forming units (CFUs).⁵

Antiquorum sensing activity assay:

Quorum sensing inhibitory assay of C. ternatea and 2% chlorohexidine will be done by employing Chromobacterium violaceum (ATCC 12472) according to the method of Choo et al. C. violaceum will be grown in Luria Bertani (LB) broth and will be incubated at 37°C overnight. For analysis, the bacterial strain will be inoculated in an Erlenmeyer flask containing LB broth. Further,

- a. C. violaceum in LB broth will be supplemented with C. ternatea compound (Group 1)
- b. C. violaceum in LB broth will be supplemented with 2% chlorohexidine. (Group 2)
- c. C. violaceum in LB broth with tetracycline standard (2 mg/ mL). (Positive control)
- d. C. violaceum in LB broth. (Negative control)

All flasks will be incubated at room temperature overnight. To precipitate the insoluble violacein, one ml of culture from each flask will be centrifuged at $13.000\times g$ for 10 mins.. The culture supernatant will be discarded and one ml of DMSO will be added to the pellet. The solution will be mixed for 30 seconds until violacein was soluble and centrifuged at $13.000\times g$ for 10 mins to remove the debris cells. A $200~\mu L$ of supernatant containing violacein will be added to a 96-well microplate. The absorbance will be measured at 595 nm using a micro titre plate reader. Antiquorum sensing activity of C. ternatea and 2% chlorhexidine will be expressed as absorbance of the remained violacein compared with that of the negative control. 1,6

Statistical Analysis:

All the experiments in this study will be done in triplicates. For the continuous quantitative variables mean and standard deviation will be calculated. For comparison if the data is divided into two groups with respect to certain qualitative characteristic, the continuous variables will be compared using suitable tools of statistics like student's unpaired t test. The pre and post treatment measures will be compared using student's paired t test

Discrete variables will be represented by median.

For discrete variables nonparametric tests will be used.

Apart from the above suitable tools like ANOVA, correlation, regression etc., will be used according to the need.

Suitable graphs will be used to depict the comparison.

For all the tests the value of p less than 5% (0.05) will be considered significant.

IMPLICATIONS:

Caries leads to irreversible permanent deformation of the tooth structure causing loss of function and pain. Research on caries prevention is ongoing and current measures for the same seems unsatisfactory. Natural herbal extracts are great measures to prevent caries without disturbing the ecological balance. C. ternatea, after further evaluation, could be added to toothpastes, mouth rinses, varnishes, chewing gums and to a later even into dentin bonding agents, so that the initiation and progression of biofilm could be prevented. Thus, herbal extract can lead to improved prevention and early management of dental caries which are needed to combat this disease.
