- To encourage hepatitis B vaccination for students and staff (Teaching & non teaching)
- To create awareness regarding needle stick injury and post exposure prophylaxis
- To monitor supply and use of personal protective equipment on regular basis
- To prepare Patient Safety manual

CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. The infection control committee holds meeting quarterly
- The infection control committee monitors activities for sterilization protocol fumigation process needle stick injury and use of PPE
- 3. Students are encouraged to use PPE while working in the clinics & made aware of standard infection control protocol and vaccinated for hepatitis B before they start their clinical posting (IIIrd BDS) with their consent.

VACCINATION AND IMMUNIZATION

Three dose hepatitis B vaccine schedule.

The hepatitis B vaccine is administered as a three dose series on σ ,1 and 6 months schedule

SHOT	PERIOD
1 st Shot	The day of vaccination
2 nd Shot	Atleast 1 month (28 days)
	after the 1st shot
3 rd Shot	6 months after the 1 st shot

Dose 2 should be separated by dose 1 by at least 1 month (4 weeks or 28 days)

Dose 3 should be separated by dose 2 by at least 2 months (8 weeks) and from

dose 1 by at least 4 months (16 weeks)

If the person is unaware of the past vaccine drive, the person schedule is started from the first dose.

A person without protective surface antibodies after completing full series of hepatitis b vaccine and for whom an acute or are chronic hepatitis B infection has been ruled out is considered as 'non responder' . It could be attributed to the past infection with Hepatitis B.

2 nd Shot	1 month (28 days) after the 1 st shot
3 rd Shot	9 months after the 2 nd shot
