
































HAND ON WORK SHOP ON BASIC LIFE SUPPORT 2021-2022

Basic Life Support, or BLS, generally refers to the type of care that first-responders, healthcare providers and public safety professionals provide to anyone who is experiencing cardiac arrest, respiratory distress or an obstructed airway. It requires knowledge and skills in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), using automated external defibrillators (AED) and relieving airway obstructions in patients of every age.

In addition to the physical skills necessary for providing BLS care to those in need, those working in basic life support also need to have critical-thinking and problem-solving skills, and be able to work as part of a team to deliver the best care possible and improve patient outcomes. The training in BLS can be undertaken by anyone. His/her need not be a health care professional.

Maratha Mandal's Nathajirao G.Halgekar Institute of Dental Sciences and Research Centre, Belagavi started hands on workshop on BLS in 2016. The first workshop was held on 29.09.2016. The programme provides extensive training on BLS covering all intricate aspects. The course is conducted over 2 days (Crossing 15hours)

Since 2016 a total of 19 workshops have been conducted that includes teaching and non-teaching staff of the institute, undergraduate and postgraduate students, internees, private practitioners and school teachers. The details are as below.










CDE PROGRAM FOR INTERNS








DJ NIGHT - 2017



Having said all that now, Yet tacenda remains my heart's content.




