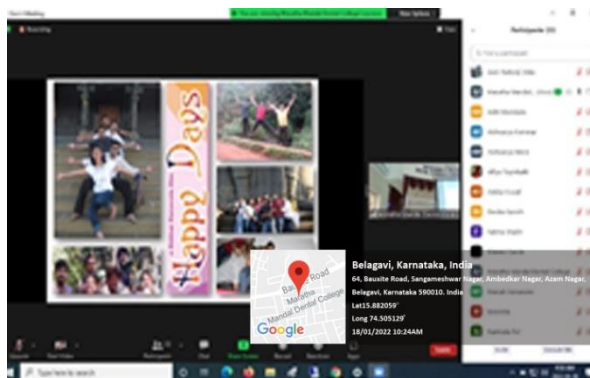
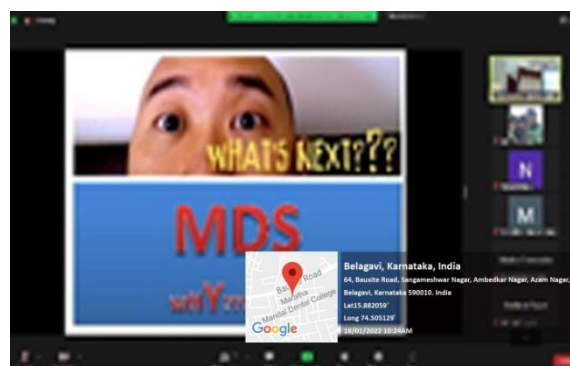
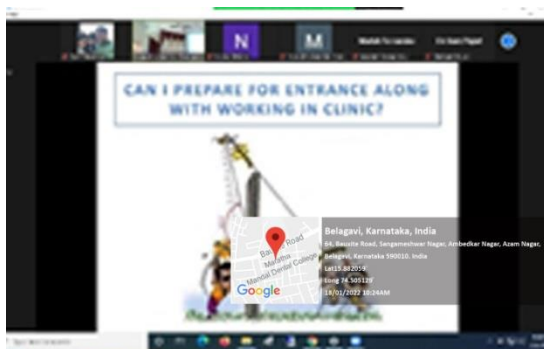

ANALYTICAL SKILL DEVELOPMENT

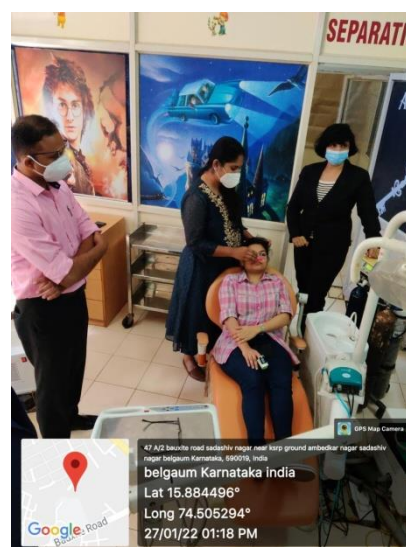
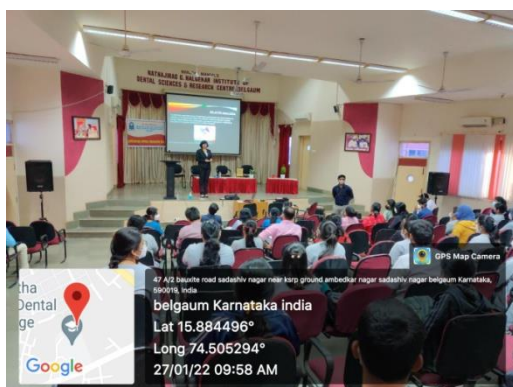

HAND ON WORK SHOP ON BASIC LIFE SUPPORT

Basic Life Support, or BLS, generally refers to the type of care that first-responders, healthcare providers and public safety professionals provide to anyone who is experiencing cardiac arrest, respiratory distress or an obstructed airway. It requires knowledge and skills in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), using automated external defibrillators (AED) and relieving airway obstructions in patients of every age. In addition to the physical skills necessary for providing BLS care to those in need, those working in basic life support also need to have critical-thinking and problem-solving skills, and be able to work as part of a team to deliver the best care possible and improve patient outcomes. The training in BLS can be undertaken by anyone. His/her need not be a health care professional. Since 2016 a total of 19 workshops have been conducted that includes teaching and non-teaching staff of the institute, undergraduate and postgraduate students, interneers, private practitioners and school teachers. The details are as below.

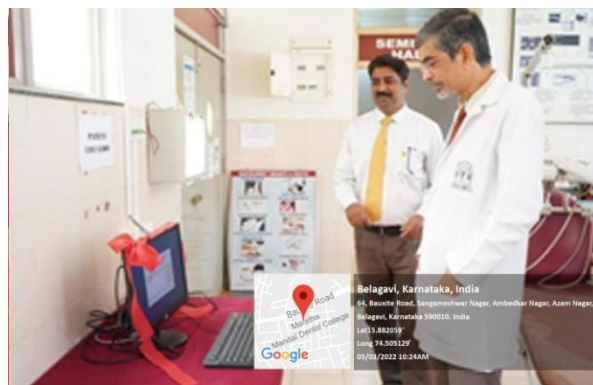
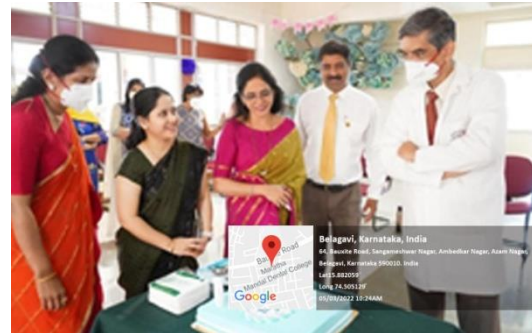
NATIONAL ORAL PATHOLOGIST DAY

ORIENTATION PROGRAM AND BRIDGE COURSE

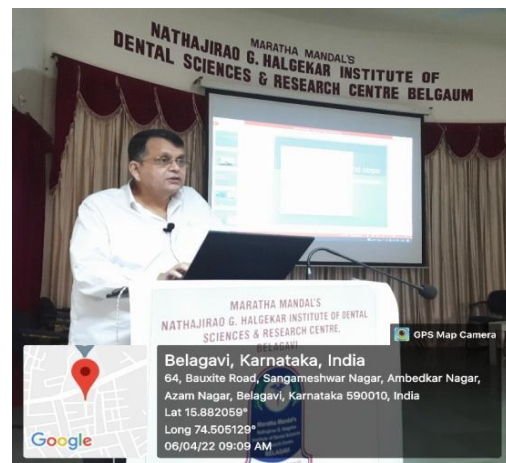
