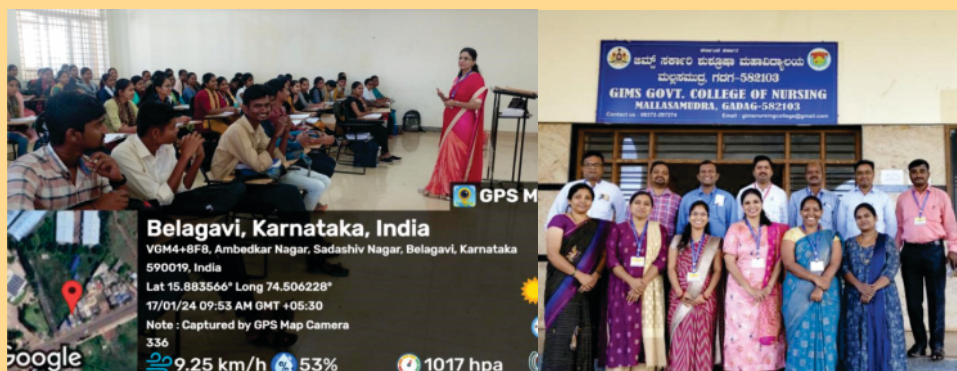

## BASIC LIFE SUPPORT (BLS) TRAINING PROGRAMME

On World Heart Day in 2016, the Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery started the Basic Life Support (BLS) training programme, which has been running effectively ever since. On January 30th and 31st, 2024, 46 undergraduate students received two days of BLS training. A pre-workshop test was administered to the students on the first day to gauge their basic understanding of the subject. Next, over the course of two days, the students received lectures and practical demonstrations. They are given a variety of real-world examples to help them comprehend the concept of BLS and how to perform it during the training. The students were trained individually and provided CPR masks. An automatic external defibrillator (AED) and interactive manikins were used to train the students. Each aspect of BLS was discussed. After they had mastered BLS skills in a variety of settings, they were evaluated in a post-workshop assessment. MCQ, OSCE, and OSPE formats were used for the exam. The students received a certificate and a placard with BLS training instructions upon successfully completing the course.

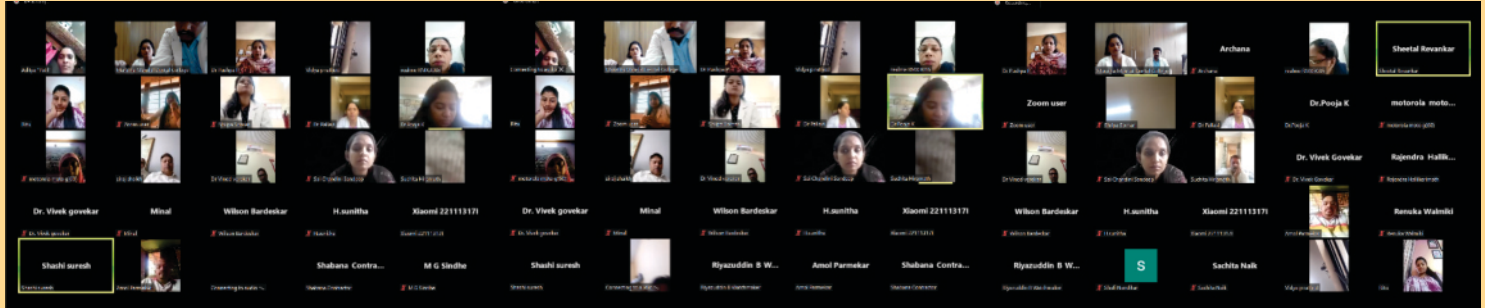

## PATENT FOR LIGHT - EQUIPPED INTRAORAL SUCTION DEVICE

Dr. Abhijit Patil, Reader, Department of Prosthodontics and Crown and Bridge, along with fellow dentists, received a Certificate of Registration of Design (Design No. 404088-001) from the Patent Office, Government of India, for the "Light-Equipped Intraoral Suction Device." The patent was issued on March 15, 2024, and will be in force for a period of 10 years. This innovative design has an external oral suction device equipped with UV-C irradiation, two HEPA high-precision filters, and activated carbon and plasma sterilization which reduces the risk of cross-infection between doctors and patients.

## MEDICO-ENGINO HACKATHON 2024
