

#### **NATIONAL DOCTORS' DAY**

The Department of Public Health Dentistry celebrated National Doctors' Day on July 1st, 2022. Dental camps were conducted at Shantai Vrudhashram and the Seventh Day Adventist English Medium High School. Breakfast was provided by our institute at Shantai Vrudhashram. In the high school, "Ek Selfie Doctor Ke Saath" was encouraged, and selfies were taken with students on the school premises. A total of 110 people were screened, and health education was given on healthy living and COVID-appropriate behaviours.



# COMMUNICATION SKILLS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

On July 18, 2022, the Department of Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopedics organized a CDE programme on communication skills development at our institution. The program's focus was on learning not just why to speak, but also how to speak. The event's keynote speaker was Ms. Smitha Dalvi, a trainer for communication skills at ICAI (the Institute of Chartered Accountancy of India). The programme had two sessions, followed by a Q&A session. In the first session, the speaker covered topics like the usage of formal and informal communication and body language. scheme. The valedictory function was held on July 16th, 2022, in the Department of Prosthodontics and Crown & Bridge. Dr. Mahesh V. Kivadasannavar, District Family Welfare Officer, and Dr. Pradeep D. Somannavar, Dental Health Officer, Community Health Center, Nandgad, graced the occasion. Dr. Mahesh V. Kivadasannavar explained the scheme in detail and asked the patients to inform their relatives and friends about it. Dr. Mahesh V. Kivadasannavar also praised the postgraduate students and staff members of the Department of Prosthodontics and Crown & Bridge for their contributions to the event's success. Complete dentures were distributed to the 15 enrolled patients.

#### VANAMAHOSTAV 2022- TARU NIRMITI ABHIYAAN

The NSS and Youth Red Cross units of our institute celebrated Vanamahotsav on July 23rd, 2022, in a unique way. Mrs. Bharti Hardi, an environmentalist and convener of JITO's ladies Wing, Belagavi, visited our institute and delivered a guest lecture on "Indian Oxygen Plants" to create awareness on native oxygen-producing plants among the students and staff. The lecture focused on various indigenous native plants like kadamba, amla, sita ashoka, bakula, parijata jamun, ramphal, tamarind, etc. and their scientific uses. An excellent live demonstration of the creation of "seed balls" was given after the lecture. Each seed ball is made up of 40 to 50 different seeds that have been mixed with soil, ash, water, cow dung, and neem powder. These balls are thrown into valleys and forests where they will break down and the seeds will gradually grow into trees. Our institute will undertake this initiative by establishing a seed bank to gather different varieties of seeds and then making more than 300 seed balls with the intention of reforestation in valleys. # **ORAL HYGIENE DAY**



# NATIONAL-LEVEL SYMPOSIUM ON RECENT ADVANCEMENTS IN DIGITAL DENTISTRY

The Department of Pediatric and Preventive Dentistry hosted a national-level symposium on recent advancements in digital dentistry on August 2nd and 3rd, 2022. The two-day workshop, PIXELATE 2022, attracted a lot of attention and participation from many states around the country. For the programme, cutting-edge devices like intraoral scanners, 3D printers, and milling equipment were flown in from different regions of India.

Digital Dentistry is the most recent branch of dentistry that strives to digitize the whole treatment process for the sake of patients' convenience, precision, and quality assurance. There is no need for conventional measurements of dental arches (impressions), which can cause the patient extreme discomfort and gagging. Now, everything is done digitally with just a click of the scanner. The collected data of the patient is uploaded to the digital cloud, where it can be instantly accessed by any dental lab worldwide, whether it be in Dubai, London, or the US. A patient's tooth or teeth can be digitally measured in Belagavi and transmitted anywhere in the world for fabrication of a 100% accurate prosthesis, aligner, or other dental device. This proves to be a boon to patients, especially young children who cannot sit still during a conventional impression-making procedure.



The youngest patient who was scanned live during this workshop was just 3 years old! The participants were amazed and thrilled to see how a digital crown (tooth cap) could be simply 3D printed within 30 minutes! Our institute has thus made its entry into the echelons of the most coveted digital dentistry world by hosting this advanced program. The Inauguration was a grand affair attended by the Principal, Dr. Ramakant Nayak, the HOD of Pediatrics and Preventive Dentistry, Dr. Chandrashekar Yavagal, and a galaxy of digital dentistry proponents from all across India-Dr. Shiva Shankar (Bangalore), Dr. Smriti Dattani (Mumbai), and Dr. Krishna Chaitanya (Hyderabad).





# **KEYNOTE SPEAKER AT SAAPD**
