SWACHH BHARAT ABHIYAN 2022

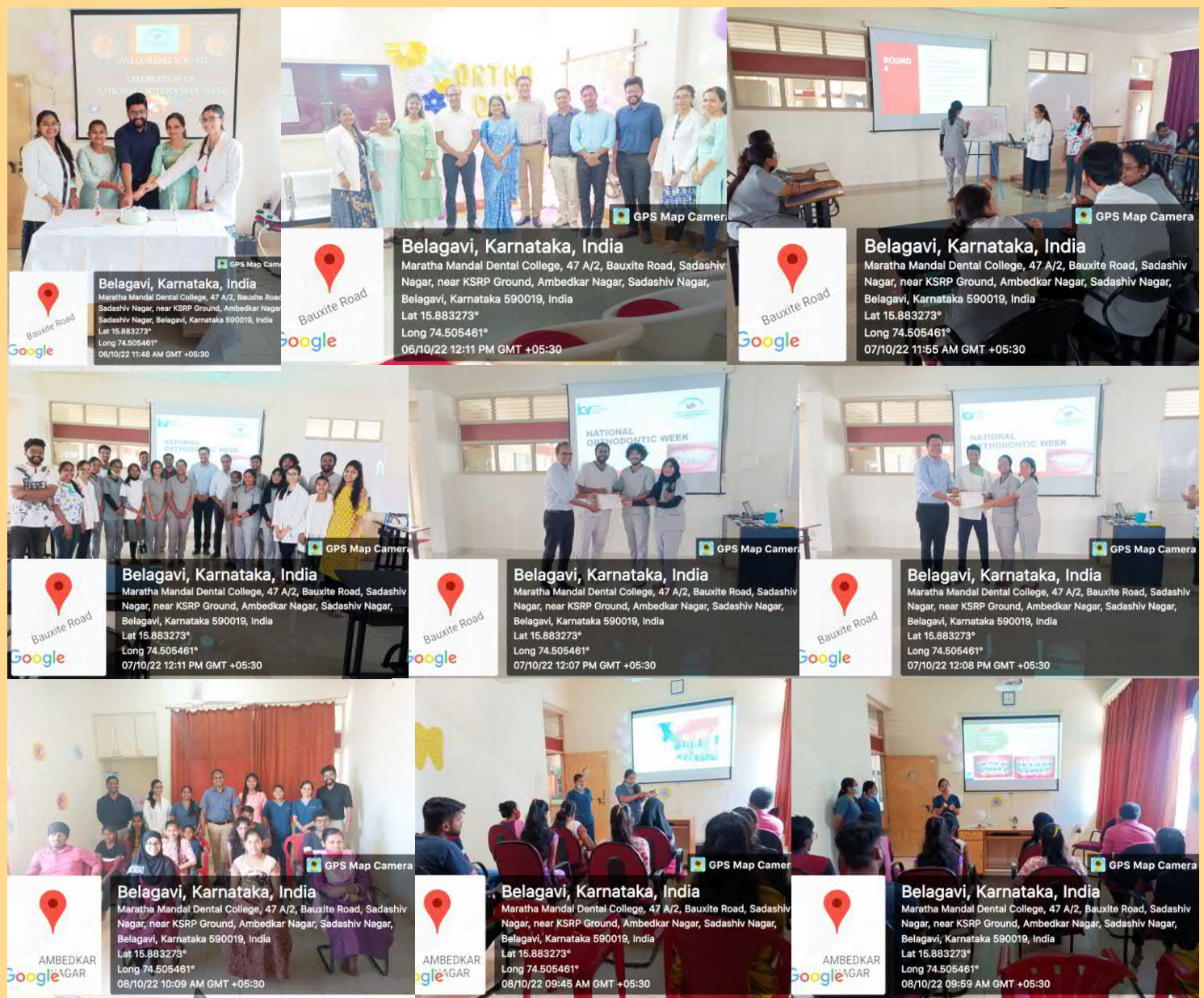

The inaugural ceremony began with a welcome address by Dr. Ramya Pai, NSS Incharge, followed by a floral tribute to our Father of the Nation, Mahatma Gandhiji, by Principal Dr. Ramakant Nayak and Youth Red Cross Incharge, Dr. Umesh Bhosle. 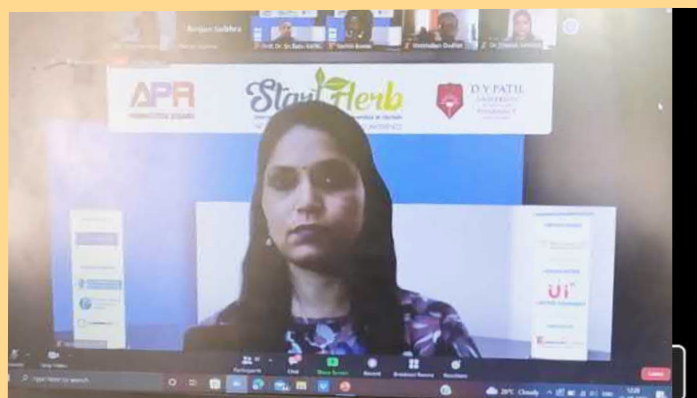
AIC BASIC IMPLANT TRAINING COURSE - PROSTHETIC MODULE

RESEARCH TOOL DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP

Our institute deputed Dr. Renuka Ammanagi, Dr. Sheetal Sanikop, Dr. Abhijit Patil, and Dr. Sachita Naik to attend a two-day hands-on workshop on "Research Tool Development" held on October 17th and 18th, 2022 at JNMC, Belagavi. The resource persons for the workshop were Dr. Gautham Melur Sukumar, Additional Professor, Epidemiology and Public Health, NIMHANS, Bengaluru, and Dr. Tarun Bhatnagar, "Scientist F," National Institute of Epidemiology (NIE), ICMR, Chennai. The two-day workshop consisted of extensive lectures on research tools, data collection, and its relevance in construct and content validation. Participants were also exposed to various software used for research tool development.



ENDODONTIC AND ESTHETIC EDIFICATION

A three-day workshop on "Endodontic and Esthetic Edification" was conducted by the Department of Conservative Dentistry and Endodontics. The workshop included basic and rotary endodontics and direct composite restorations. 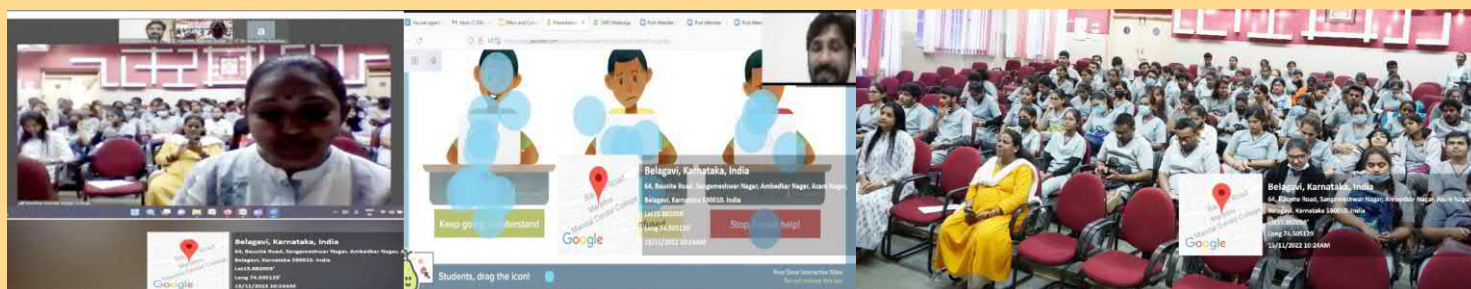
STAFF BEST PAPER AWARD
